

## RESOLUTION NO. 2009-47

### ELECTION RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CARLSBAD

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CARLSBAD that:

A regular municipal election for the election of municipal officers shall be held Tuesday, March 2, 2010. Polls will open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 p.m.

A. The following offices shall be filled:

One Mayor for a four-year term.  
One Councilor for a four-year term from Ward 1.  
One Councilor for a four-year term from Ward 2.  
One Councilor for a four-year term from Ward 3.  
One Councilor for a four-year term from Ward 4.

One Councilor for a two-year term from Ward 2.  
One Councilor for a two-year term from Ward 4.

B. Persons desiring to register to vote at the regular municipal election must register with the County Clerk of Eddy County not later than Tuesday, February 2, 2010 at 5:00 p.m., the date on which the County Clerk will close registration books.

C. Declarations of Candidacy shall be filed with the Municipal Clerk on Tuesday, January 5, 2010 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

D. Declarations for Write-in Candidacy shall be filed with the Municipal Clerk on Tuesday, January 12, 2010 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

E. Absentee Voting. Any qualified elector of the City of Carlsbad shall obtain an application for an absentee ballot, only from the office of the Municipal Clerk. All applications for an absentee ballot must be completed and accepted by the Municipal Clerk prior to 5:00 p.m., Friday, February 26, 2010. After 5:00 p.m. on Friday, February 26, 2010, all unused absentee ballots will be publicly destroyed by the Municipal Clerk. The Municipal Clerk will be issuing Absentee Ballots using equipment to generate ballots on demand. The Municipal Clerk will accept completed absentee ballots delivered by mail, or in person by the voter casting the absentee ballot or by a member of the

voter's immediate family, or by the caregiver to the voter until 7:00 p.m. on March 2, 2010.

Absentee ballots may be marked in person in the office of the Municipal Clerk during the regular hours and days of business beginning on Tuesday, January 26 and closing at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, February 26, 2010.

Absentee voting on paper ballots counted by M100 electronic vote tabulator will be conducted in the office of the Municipal Clerk during the regular hours and days of business, beginning Wednesday, February 10, 2010 and closing at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, February 26, 2010.

F. The Wards within the City are listed below with the consolidated Precincts and designated polling places within each Ward:

Ward 1: Consolidated Precincts 10, and all of Precinct 34 lying within the city limits. That portion of Precinct 35 that is south of Lea Street and within the city limits except for those portions of Precinct 35 lying south of and adjacent to Lea Street and north of Union Street extended to the northwest corner of Brazeal Subdivision. All of Precinct 11 lying within the city limits, except for that portion between Canal Street and the Burlington Northern Railroad, from Lea Street to Fiesta Drive. Voters shall vote at San Jose Hall, 1002 DeBaca.

Consolidated Precincts 12, all of Precinct 13 lying within the city limits, and all of Precinct 14, except for that portion lying between Fox Street and Mermod Street from the CID Canal to Alameda Street. Voters shall vote at Alta Vista Middle School, 301 South Alta Vista Street.

Ward 2: Consolidated Precincts 16, all of Precinct 15 lying within the city limits, and those portions of Precinct 35 north of Lea Street and south of the Seven Rivers Highway lying within the city limits, and those portions of Precinct 35 which are south of and adjacent to Lea Street and north of Union Street extended to the northwest corner of Brazeal Subdivision. Voters shall vote at Hillcrest Baptist Church, 605 North Sixth Street.

Consolidated Precincts 17, 18, and that portion of Precinct 37 lying within the city limits. Voters shall vote at the American Legion Hall, 2605 Legion Avenue.

Ward 3: Consolidated Precincts 25 and 26. Voters shall vote at the Epworth United Methodist Church, 1406 West Blodgett Street.

Consolidated Precincts 21, 23, that portion of Precinct 14 that lies between Fox Street and Mermod Street from the CID Canal to Alameda Street, and that portion of Precinct 20 that lies between Canal Street and the Burlington Northern Railroad from Church Street to Mermod Street. Voters shall vote at the First United Methodist Church, 207 North Halagueno Street.

Precinct 27. Voters shall vote at St. Peter Lutheran Church, 1302 West Pierce Street.

Ward 4: Consolidated Precincts 19 and 36 lying within the city limits, that portion of Precinct 11 lying between Canal Street and the Burlington Northern Railroad from Lea Street to Fiesta Street, and all of Precinct 20 except for that portion lying between Canal Street and the Burlington Northern Railroad from Church Street to Mermod Street. Voters shall vote at the Carlsbad Municipal Golf Pro Shop, 901 Muscatel Avenue.

Consolidated Precincts 9, 33 lying within the city limits and 44 that lies within the City limits. Voters shall vote at Puckett School, 2212 Primrose Street.

Consolidated Precincts 28 and 45 lying within the city limits. Voters shall vote at Riverside School, 1600 Johnson Street.

G. The casting of votes by qualified municipal electors shall be recorded on paper ballots to be counted by M100 electronic vote tabulators.
